Ethel Marie Hansen was given life by her Creator and was born on April 8, 1929, the child of Lee Greenwood and Lura Daniels. On May 13, 1951 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Great Bend, Kansas, she received the gift of Holy Baptism, became a child of God, and publicly confessed her faith and was confirmed all on the same day.
